


Wistron NeWeb Corporation (WNC) places great emphasis on biodiversity and forest conservation. To this end WNC's President & CEO has signed a WNC Biodiversity and No Gross Deforestation Commitment, affirming the company's pledge toward protecting the environment.

WNC Biodiversity and No Gross Deforestation Commitment

WNC is committed to continually improving its operations, products, and services. It encourages its suppliers and partners in the value chain to take action alongside the company to achieve the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs), including SDG 9: Industry, Innovation, and Infrastructure, SDG 13: Climate Action, SDG 15: Life on Land, and SDG 17: Partnerships. Through these efforts, WNC looks to minimize the impact of its operations on the environment.

1. Pay close attention to the ecological features of operational locations and commit to protecting ecosystems in key biodiversity areas with the goal of achieving Net Positive Impact by 2050 and avoidance of participation in gross deforestation processes.
2. Avoid biodiversity-sensitive areas, critical habitat or natural conservation areas for new manufacturing sites and offices and adopt construction methods with low environmental impact. Promote biodiversity measures including biodiversity risk assessment and monitoring to mitigate the impact of operational processes on the environment.
3. Proactively collaborate with internal and external stakeholders to implement biodiversity protection plans and continue to raise awareness among stakeholders concerning the importance of biodiversity and forest conservation.
4. Evaluate life cycle of green products, and continue to promote and require the use of paper materials from Forest Stewardship Council (FSC) certified manufacturers or other environmentally friendly forest materials, or utilize recycled eco-friendly paper and environmentally friendly ink printing.
5. Collaborate with academic and research institutions to promote afforestation projects, giving priority to Taiwan's native species to improve ecological resilience, enrich bio-diversity, and enhance carbon sequestration capacity.
6. Implement paperless practices across all production sites and office areas, reducing printed documents and replacing paper printing with electronic operations.
7. Promote environmental and biodiversity education, build eco-friendly awareness, and foster harmonious development between humans and the environment.
